Hello Church,

I know that many of you have been asking about our plans for June. The Elders, Consistory and our new Corona Task Force have met and discussed all the

relevant matters. Our goal will be to return to having services live at the church on June 14th. This will allow time to see in which direction the numbers of new infections go and give us time to prepare the technical matters that must be addressed. We have collected information from the UCC conference office, local health departments and from as many of you as we could. Please know that these decisions are not easy to make as we have a lot of differing opinions about having worship at church again.

If we do not see a spike in numbers, we will plan on meeting inside beginning on June 14th for the rest of June. The reason we are planning on meeting inside is so that we can keep our technical setup that has been working very well for us. As we normally would, we will plan to meet outside beginning in July. When we do return, we will not be passing the peace, the offering plate, or bulletins. We will not be singing as a congregation and people will be strongly encouraged to wear masks. (We will have masks on hand for you to wear). Bathrooms will be open only on the main floor with only one person at a time using them. We will also be sitting every other row. Please note that those who are at risk will be encouraged to continue to stay home and enjoy the worship service that is presented online as we will continue to do for the foreseeable future. When we have communion, we will do so with sealed kits that contain the juice and bread.

The office will be available during most normal business hours if you need something at the church. Our committee meetings that have been taking place online will be held at the church property using masks and social distancing, outside when possible. Our community dinner on the 21^{st} was a success. We served just about as many as we normally would have. We are making plans to do it again on the third Thursday of June, the 18^{th} , in the same manner – a drive up distribution. It turned out to be a relatively easy process. We are not planning to have our community breakfast for the foreseeable future. If you have any questions or comments, you can direct those to any member of the task force. We have included this information later in the newsletter. Thanks for your patience with us regarding this process as nothing like this has ever happened before and we are navigating as best we can.

I ask that you continue to pray for our church and for our leaders during this. It has not been easy to make decisions about this. We are grateful that we have still been able to have meaningful moments online. Thank you for supporting each other during this crisis. The Spirit of God has been evident in keeping us connected and vibrant. We the people are the church now more than ever! God Bless you and your family as we begin summer.

PANDEMIC UPDATE

Consistory, at its May meeting, created a Corona Compliance Team consisting of Doug Court, Darrin Harvey, Brad Hocker, Doug Stone, and Brian Treisch. Adair Pittman has also been added to the team. The intent of the team is to create a safe and meaningful return to congregational worship. The team is monitoring local corona data for the next two weeks and plans to open in sanctuary worship, if infection rates stabilize or lower. June 14 is our target date. You will receive more information about worship style and protective procedure in a later mailing. What we need now is a good idea of how many worshippers we can expect when we open our sanctuary doors. REPORT FROM THE FINANCE COMMITTEE

The Finance Committee has continued to meet every two weeks by video conference. We have done so to keep the Elders and Consistory apprised of our financial situation, so they can make informed decisions.


Last month, we reported we were running about 85% of budgeted giving in a year over year comparison. As of mid-May, this has improved slightly to 88% of budgeted giving. On line giving has increased during the period of shut down.

Again this month, the committee would like to extend a sincere thank you. We had no idea how not meeting in person for worship would affect the church financially. We are very thankful we have been able to meet our obligations and pay our bills. It is likely we will have to look at our budget differently as the year progresses. To date however, we have not had to use budgeted reserve funds because of your continued support.

If you are in a position to give, offering envelopes can be mailed and the church office collects these daily. On line giving is also an option and instructions are provided on a previous page. Thank you to everyone who continues to keep our church in mind financially during this unprecedented time.
